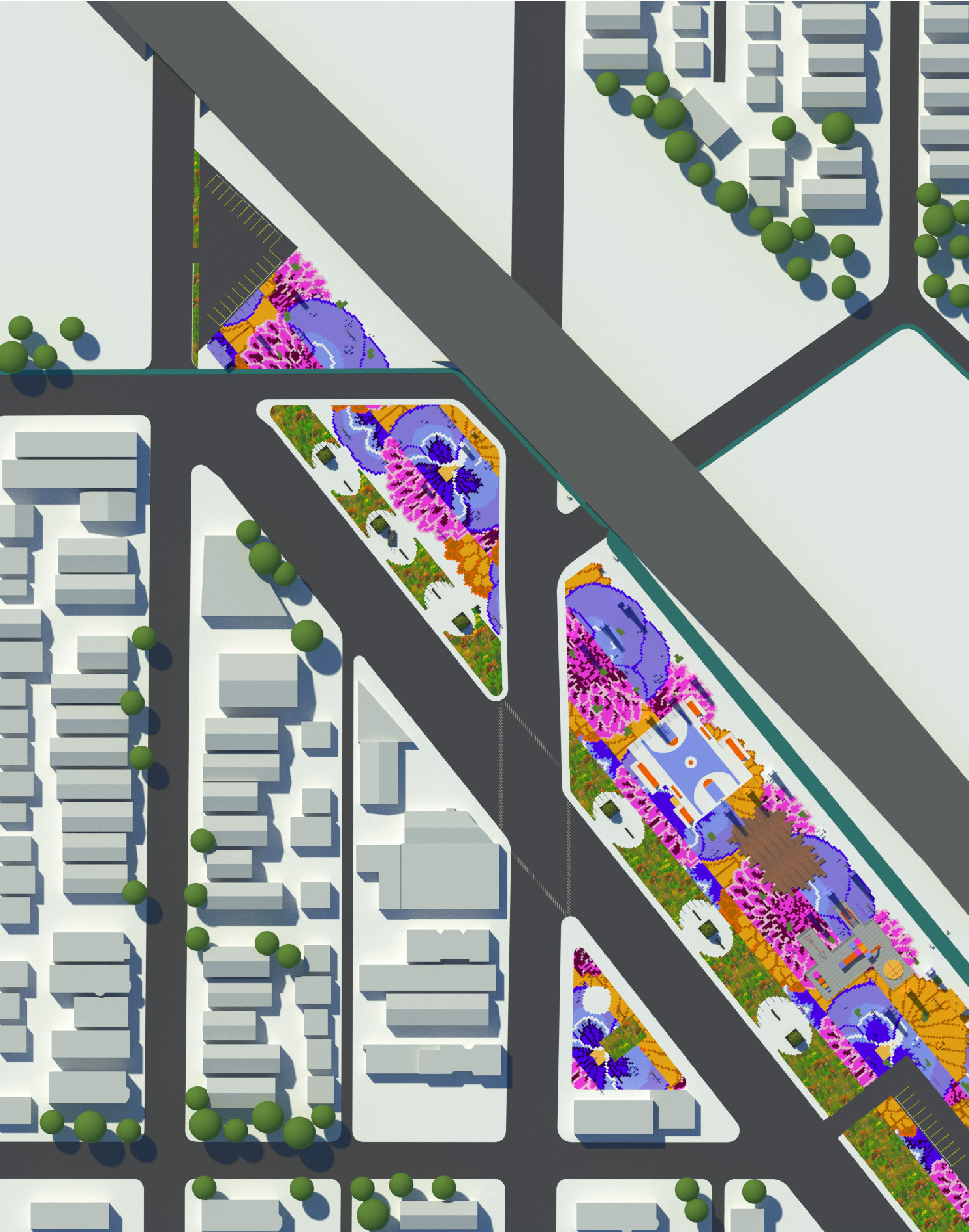


EASTSIDE MEMORAL PARK

The basketball court is meant to be an exercise space within the park.



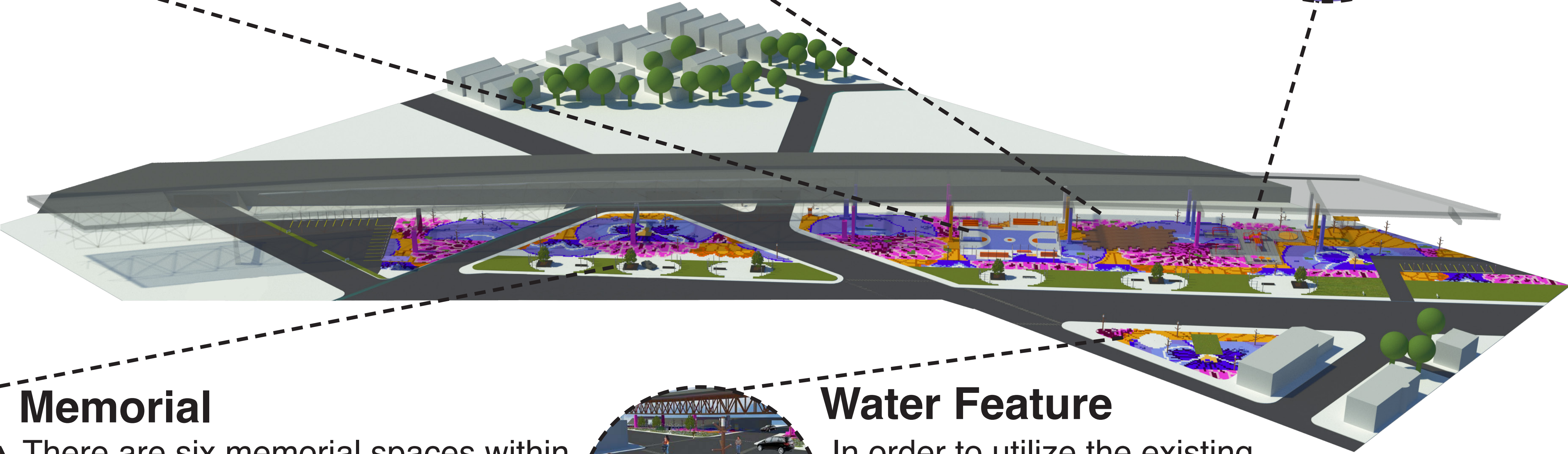
Stage
